Project Rules:

- 1. Youth ages 8-18 may register to collect **two free** marigold plants and **two free** tomato plants. Adult contact information is required for registration.
- 2. Youth do not need to be a 4-H club member to participate.
- 3. Youth may enter <u>one plant per category</u> (marigold or tomato) in the Lucas County Junior Fair. No cost to enter a youth mini-garden in the Junior Fair.
- 4. A single marigold plant must be in a one-gallon or smaller sized pot for project entry.
- 5. A single tomato plant must be in a three-to-five-gallon sized container for project entry. Plant must be staked. No caged plants are allowed.
- 6. Projects must follow rules in order to be eligible for prizes.

Project Timeline:

May 1, 2022: Deadline to register for coupon code to collect free plants. Adults may include up to 20 youth per registration form. Coupons are sent via email. go.osu.edu/lucasminigarden

May 13-14, 2022: Collect plants by showing coupon at participating greenhouses.
