### **Project Judging Requirements:**

- 1. Project Divisions: Project Books #631, #751 and #757 Senior: 14-18 years of age and Junior: 8-13 years of age, and Cloverbuds Project Book #631 ONLY.
- 2. Note: Clover Buds Project #631 Only, NOT #751 and are judged on that project.
- 3. Each member will bring their completed archery project for judging to the designated location and time on the announced day of judging.
- 4. Project Requirements: Each member to be judged must exhibit a poster, a <u>completed</u> project book and their archery notebook/scrapbook annually.
- 5. Required Poster Size: <u>Tri-Fold</u> Poster Board Only (48" x 36" max; or 40" x 28" min) <u>No Flat Posters</u>
- 6. No actual archery arrow tips/points will be exhibited as part of any project poster or display
- 7. No actual arrow longer than 6"may be displayed on any poster or project.

### NO Arrow Tips, Points or Assembled Bows Allowed as part of any exhibit

- 8. Each 4-H member enrolled in project may enter only one project entry per year.
- 9. Each 4-H member must be present for judging and interviewed by the judge in order to be considered for Project Grade, Top County Awards and/or State Fair Delegate(s) one delegate per Senior and Junior divisions, to be determined by the age of the 4-H youth.
- 10. 4-H Members and Clover Buds taking Archery Projects #631 or #751 will be interviewed and evaluated on their knowledge of elements, principles and techniques used in archery, along with their skills and abilities as seen in their exhibit and their understanding and knowledge through their project work.
- 11. All archery project posters, project books and notebooks/scrapbooks will remain on display in the archery booth during the week of Fair.
- 12. Proper Attire for judging: Clean and pressed apparel is required for both young men and women. Show attire, Sunday Best or Business Casual; includes: club T-shirts, jeans, khaki pants or Bermuda/cargo shorts with closed-toed shoes, boots, clean tennis shoes, dress-shoes are acceptable for judging. Hair is to be neat and clean and combed. No hair in face or eyes. Long hair must be tied back and secured. Make-up and jewelry at a minimum. No Chewing Gum or Tobacco Use before entering project judging area or during judging.
- 13. Judge's Decision is final for placings and awards
- 14. Awards: Ribbons (may include grade, placing, outstanding of the day, best of show and state fair delegate)
