First Time at the Lucas County Fair Livestock Auction?

When you participate in the livestock auction, you are sponsoring the youth in the project to recognize their hard work and dedication. The money goes to the youth to help offset the cost of raising and caring for their animals.

What you bid is the amount you pay. Remember, this is just sponsoring the youth and their project. If you wish to purchase the animal for your freezer, you are responsible for paying the market price, taking the animal on Sunday night, and scheduling a processing location.

If you are unable to attend the Livestock Auction, you can still support youth by completing our Auction Support form. Submit an auction support form with:

- The name of a specific youth you wish to support and the desired amount
- A dollar amount to allow someone to attend and bid on youth(s) using their discretion.
- A blanket amount for a select species or all livestock youth. Each year, we have approximately 50 showmen. A blanket donation of \$1000 would give each youth \$20.
